

All questions based on road code

What happens in the test

Must get 32 questions right to pass

On test day





Take photo ID



Take glasses if you wear them



When you get your learner licence



Take your licence

with you at all times

Must display L plates



Zero alcohol for under 20s



Must have supervisor (full licence for 2 years) with you at all times

Now you have your learner licence - what next?

Start out slow and build up practice



Plan lessons beforehand



Practise in the safest vehicle possible



Don't make lessons too long



Expect mistakes, they are a part of learning
